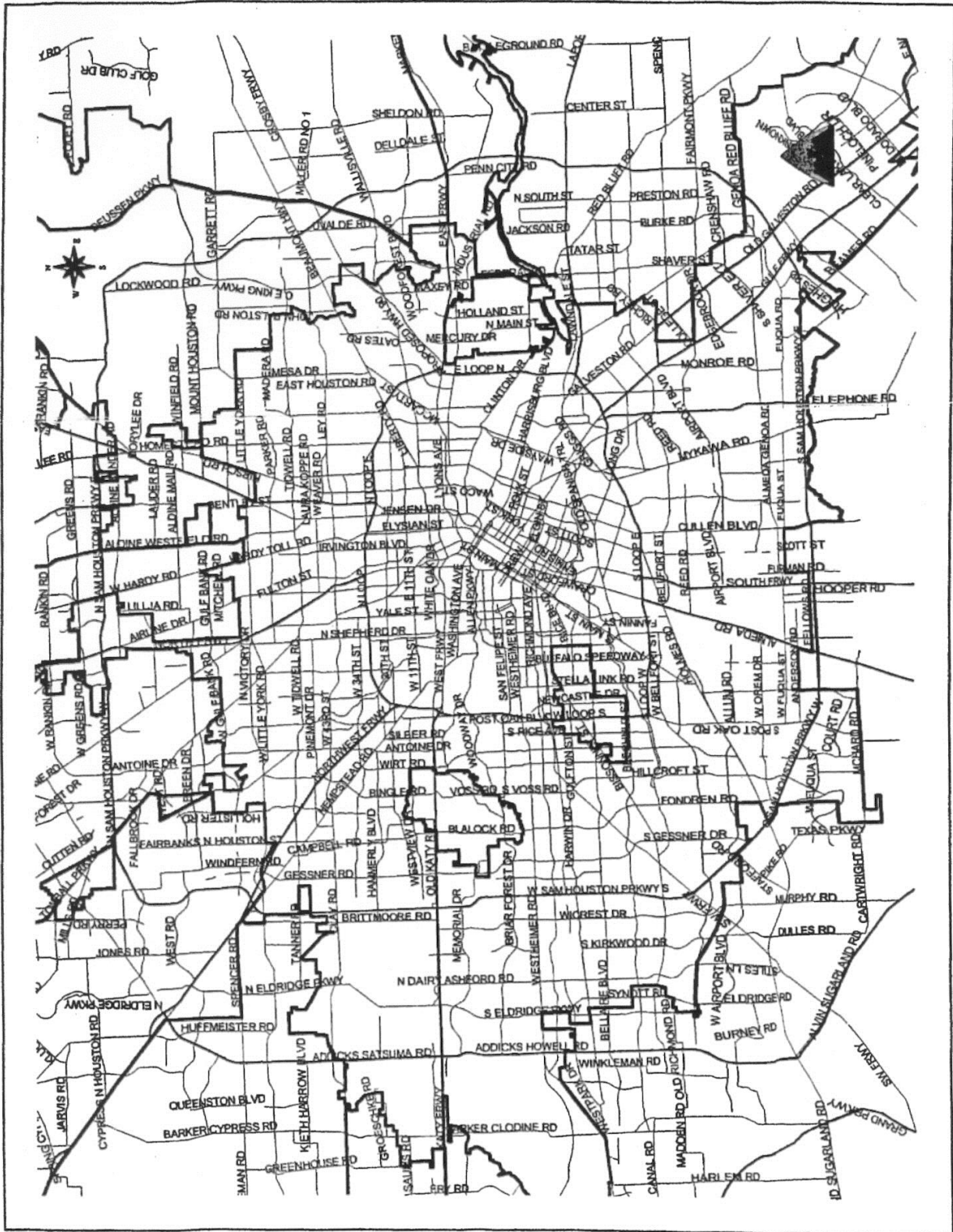

Bag Dispensers	\$ 250.00
Tree with irrigation (1 – 30 gal.)	\$ 500.00
Signage	\$6,000.00
Drinking Fountain with Dog Bowl	\$3,000.00
Information Kiosk	\$1,500.00
Water Tap – depends upon site	-
Irrigation per acre	\$5,000.00
